**Hiring of
State Anchor Person
through Internal Selection Process
from existing Young Professionals of BRLPS**

Government of India, (MoRD-NRLM) vide its DO Letter No-J11011/05/2012 (Ajeevika), dated 23.02.2012, identified BRLPS as NRO (National Resource Organization). Further, BRLPS is also recognized as NRO for integration of Food, Nutrition, Health and WASH Intervention (FNHW) and implementation as well as support to roll-out LoKOS to other SRLM vide, DO Letter No-11012/01/2011-SGSY-1(315537), dated 02.07.2020 & Letter No-F.NO-11060/08/2019-RL-Part-(3) (E-377421) dated-31.03.22 respectively.

Currently BRLPS has signed MoUs with three State Rural Livelihood Missions namely Sikkim, Gujarat & Uttarakhand for providing technical support and strengthening systems related to FNHW interventions. In order to facilitate effective implementation and handholding support to the said SRLMs, Application are invited for the position of State Anchor person from the existing Young Professionals (YPs) of BRLPS who fulfils the eligibility criteria and terms and conditions as mentioned below:

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. The State Anchor Person is responsible for overall coordination and implementation of Resource Block Strategy.
2. The State Anchor Person shall Provide support to SRLM in developing annual action plans that integrate FNHW priorities and align with NRLM's goals.
3. The State Anchor Person shall Customize and illustrate FNHW modules, adapting IEC materials to ensure consistent messaging and understanding.
4. The State Anchor Person shall Facilitate the training and development of Master Trainers with support from Health and Nutrition resource personnel.
5. The State Anchor Person shall support, monitor the performance of C-PRP.

6. The State Anchor Person shall ensure smooth execution of activities as per action plan.
7. The State Anchor Person shall support SRLM FNHW Nodal in developing SOP, cadre Policy etc.
8. The State Anchor Person shall coordinate with BRLPS for periodic drive of CRPs, deployment of C-PRP, any other.
9. The State Anchor Person shall Facilitate the dissemination of training and best practices from intensive areas to other blocks for broader impact.
10. The State Anchor Person shall Organize community events like Annaprasan Diwas and Poshan Mah to promote FNHW best practices.
11. The State Anchor Person shall Collaborate with Village Organizations (VOs), Self-Help Groups (SHGs), and other partners to drive community-based adoption of FNHW practices.
12. The State Anchor Person shall provide mentoring & hand holding support to C-PRP.
13. The State Anchor Person shall ensure smooth flow of funds from SRLM to BRLPS as per the MoU.
14. The State Anchor Person shall submit the Monthly Progress Report and also ensure filling up data in MIS.
15. The State Anchor Person shall travel extensively to the field atleast 07-10 days in a month.

Official website <http://brlps.in> may be visited and click on "Career" to apply online. All communication will be made through website only.

SELECTION PROCESS

Internal Selection process is applicable in this recruitment wherein working YPs of BRLPS are only allowed to participate in this selection process.

Selection procedure consists of the following:

Shortlisted applicants will only be invited to appear for participating in further stages of recruitment. List of applications received shortlisted applications, date and venue of tests for selection etc. would be posted in due course on www.brlps.in (<https://brlps.in/Career>). Candidates are requested to visit the website frequently for announcements. All communication will be made through website only.

Selection procedure
<p>Stage – 1. Shortlisting of Application: Shortlisting of candidates would be based on eligibility criteria of the position.</p>
<p>Stage – 2. Personal Interview: This stage consists of document verification, followed by Personal Interview. Final Result will be declared based on marks obtained in Personal Interview. Full Marks of the interview: 50 Marks Minimum Qualifying Marks in PI: 50% of Full Marks</p>

SERVICE CONDITIONS

1. After selection, the successful candidates would be empanelled for employment/deployment as per the actual demand of the concerned SRLMs.
2. Once the candidate joined as State Anchor Person of a specific state, he/she will no longer be a Young Professional of BRLPS and service condition of the State Anchor Person will only applicable to him/her.
3. Any Candidate once deployed at SRLM shall not be repatriated in BRLPS at any circumstances.
4. The honorarium & other entitlements for the State Anchor Person shall be provided by the SRLM of the state in which he/she is deployed.
5. The period of deployment will be up to the remaining duration of the MoU with a concerned SRLM.
6. The State Anchor Person will be primarily positioned at the State SRLM Office. However, the place of posting may be changed based on the requirements and requests of the respective SRLM.
7. The **honorarium for the State Anchor Person** shall be provided by the **SRLM** of the state in which he/she is deployed. A consolidated honorarium of Rs.95,000/- (**Ninety-Five Thousand Only**) will be paid by the concerned SRLM.
8. TA/DA for field visits will be provided as per the rates specified in the MoU.
9. Laptop allowance shall be discontinued during the period of deployment.


10. Leave entitlement will be governed by the respective SRLM's leave calendar. Any leave accrued during the SRLM tenure will neither be transferred to BRLPS nor be eligible for encashment.
11. Travel reimbursement for one round trip (To & Fro) in 3rd AC train from the place of posting (SRLM) to the native village will be provided once in a year.

General Terms and Conditions:

1. This is a notification for hiring of "State Anchor Person" for 3 states Sikkim, Uttarakhand and Gujarat separately.
2. Based on Internal Selection process currently working YPs in BRLPS who fullfills the eligibility criteria are allowed to participate in this selection process for the position of State Anchor Person.
3. Position of State Anchor Person is state specific therefore, candidates are allowed to apply against the vacancy of only one state. In case a candidate submits, applications for more than one state, in such scenario his/her all applications will be summarily rejected.
4. Only one application shall be submitted by each candidate for a position. In case, more than one Application i.e., multiple Application Forms are submitted by the same candidate, then the last application form correct in all respect shall only be taken into account for considering his/her candidature.
5. Applications will be accepted through online mode only.
6. Application Form of candidates who do not fulfil the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.
7. Candidates are also advised in their own interest to apply online well before the closing date and not wait for the last date of submission to avoid possibility of link failure or any other technical issues. There shall not be any responsibility of the BRLPS if any candidate fails to finally submit the Application Form before the last date of submission on account of aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond its control.
8. The candidates are required to fill the Online Application Form with correct and complete information carefully. If any incomplete or false information is furnished, then the candidate will be solely responsible for the same and on the basis of false and incomplete information, the Application Form shall be rejected at any stage of the selection process without giving any reason/ notice. On furnishing any false certificate or indicating wrong category in the Application Form or in case of any other default, the BRLPS may reject the candidature at any stage of the selection.
9. In case it is found at any time in future that a Candidate has used/ uploaded the photograph and/ or signature of someone else in his/her Application Form/ Admit Card or he/ she has tempered his/her Admit Card/ result, these acts of the candidate shall be treated as Unfair Means.
10. Print out of On-line Application Form or hard copies of certificates/mark sheets are not required to be submitted.
11. Candidates must keep print out of On-line Application Form and at least 05 (Five) copies of coloured passport size photograph identical with the photograph uploaded in Online Application Form and produce the same, along with all the required certificates, at the time of verification of the documents.
12. It is to be noted that if a candidate has been allowed to appear in the examination, it does not imply that the candidate's eligibility has been verified. It does not vest any right with such candidates to get appointment. The eligibility is subject to final verification by the Competent Authority. The candidate shall satisfy his/her eligibility before applying online and shall be personally responsible, in case, he/she is not found eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria.
13. Information uploaded on the official website of the BRLPS shall not be provided to the candidate or any other person under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The information uploaded on the official website of the BRLPS shall remain available for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidate are advised to download the uploaded information and keep it with them for future reference, if any. During the course of recruitment, neither any application under the R.T.I Act shall be entertained nor any information shall be provided.
14. Any representation filed by any applicant in respect of recruitment shall not be entertained once the process is initiated.
15. Factual information under the R.T.I. Act shall be provided only after declaration of final result. Inferential questions or speculative questions shall not be answered under the R.T.I. Act
16. In case a candidate is found providing incorrect information or his/her identity is proved to be false at any time in the future, he/ she may, in addition to disqualification, face penal action as per the law applicable
17. In case, it is found at any stage of the recruitment process that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/ she has suppressed/ twisted or truncated any material facts, his/her candidature shall stand cancelled without giving any reason and notice to the candidate concerned. If any of these shortcomings is detected even after appointment, his/ her service will be liable to be terminated and he/she will be liable to punishment through proceedings as decided by the Competent Authority.
18. Only such candidate shall be considered for selection who participates in all the stages of the Examination, and no exemption shall be granted to any candidate including that of OH Category from appearing in any part/ stage of the Examination for reasons whatsoever.

19. Candidates are requested to visit the website frequently for updates and other announcements. All recruitment related notification shall be brought to the notice of candidates only through the official website of the BRLPS. No personal communication shall be made in this regard.
20. BRLPS reserves the right to cancel this recruitment process, fully or partially, at any stage. The BRLPS reserves the right to bring about changes in the selection procedure/ scheme of Examination.
21. There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/re-checking/ scrutiny of the answer sheet/ score. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
22. Only those candidates shall be considered for selection who secures the minimum cut off marks in the Personal Interview.
23. BRLPS reserves the right to shortlist candidates based on qualification and post qualification relevant experience
24. Relevant experience is specific to the eligibility criteria and key responsibility as mentioned against the position.
25. Shortlisting will be done based on information provided by the candidates in the Application Form. No changes afterwards will be accepted in any circumstances.
26. For the purpose of calculation of service period, the reference date will be the last date of application.
27. The no. of position of State Anchor Person may increase/decrease at the time of selection, as per the requirement under MoU and actual demand of the concerned SRLM.
28. Last Date for receipt of applications is up to **14/07/2026**. Applications beyond this date will not be accepted.
