Term of Reference for Empanelment of Functional Experts and Mentors as Resource Person Under One Stop Facility Centre- Enterprise Promotion

1. Background

One Stop Facility (OSF) program is envisaged as business facilitation cum incubation centres at the sub district level to provide business development services to existing nano enterprises (enterprises having turnover of up to INR 8 lakhs per annum) on a growth track. As the enterprises grow in size, the support services required also increase and require significant handholding for support to those nano-enterprises that are on a high-growth track requiring significantly higher amount of finance and handholding.

The OSF are expected to be supported by industry experts and existing entrepreneurs, called Functional Experts and Mentors, who will help in preparation of growth plans (business planning) and will also guide the BDSPs (business development service provider; community cadre for the program) and entrepreneurs through critical business processes. They will also define the business KPIs (key performing indicators) and enable their achievement.

4. Reporting & Payment Process:

- A. Functional expert- They will report to DPM and submit the work done report, duly endorsed by Dist. Technical Expert-Enterprise Promotion (DTE EP) to DPM for payment clearance from district level.
- B. Mentor- They will report to BPM and submit the work done report, duly endorsed by BPM, & DTE EP to DPM for payment clearance from district level.

Payment will be released from concerned DPCU after submission of monthly work done report (day wise activity done) by functional expert/mentor. The budget head for booking expenditure related to Expert & Mentor is as follows:

5. Terms and Condition

- A. The letter of empanelment shall be given to the selected functional experts & mentors for their onboarding in the program.
- B. The empanelment will be valid for one year. Based on usage and performance of empanelled functional experts & mentors in one year, the extension of services of existing experts & mentors may be given for second year. Beyond second year, the empanelment process will be re-initiated.
- C. Services of the Resource Person will be taken as per requirement of the project. Empanelment doesn't guarantee allocation of work and the resources will not have claim for guaranteed work allocation. Allocation of work will depend on project's requirement. At the beginning of every month the concerned Dist. NF Nodal and BPM will prepare a work plan and intimate the functional expert and mentor respectively by mail. The maximum service days for each expert and mentor per month will be for 3 days. Any claim beyond this will not be entertained.
- D. At block level, Mentor will also attend monthly review meeting at OSF office and that day, they will be informed next month'swork plan/schedule and Mentors will also submit report of last month.
- E. Performance of the Resource Person will be reviewed every month by the competent authority at respective level (state, district, block) based on the monthly report submitted and feedback collected from the entrepreneurs as well as concerned staff during the task/assignment.
- F. The Resource Person needs to follow the work schedule and quality standard. BRLPS reserves the right to cancel the assignment at any time during the process for any reason for example if the functional expert/Mentor does not deliver as per the ToR or if found indulged in any unfair practices that bring bad names for the Project, its staff or Clients.
- G. Competent Authority is independent to act and take appropriate action against the functional expert & mentor against any malpractices observed during the work.
- H. Coordination and Review of the Resource Person Work: BRLPS officials (DPM, DTE-EP, BPM and Block Technical Coordinator- Enterprise Promotion)will provide necessary

support to the Resource Persons to carry out the assignment. Thereview of the work will be done by project team at regular interval.
