Breaking Chains, Building Dreams: The Empowering Journey of Afsana Khatoon

Afsana Khatoon, a member of the Jeevika Mahila Swyam Sahayata Samuh in Chandan Prakhanda, Suraj, found herself at a crossroads when she entered her marital home. Witnessing the dire financial situation of her household, where her husband worked away from home and she was restricted from leaving the confines of her residence, she realized the urgent need for change. A pivotal moment arose when her neighbour, a member of the Jeevika group, enlightened her in-laws about the benefits of collective action.



After much persuasion and deliberation, her in-laws consented to allow her to attend the group meetings. The discussions within the group spanned various social and employment-related topics, which Afsana diligently conveyed to her family. Eventually, she convinced her husband to procure a loan of \$\pi\$50,000 from the group to purchase four sewing machines and establish a clothing store. Today, through their joint efforts, Afsana and her husband earn a monthly income ranging from \$\pi\$12,000 to \$\pi\$15,000.

With a son to support, Afsana ensured he received a quality education, thus securing a brighter future for him. Her joy knows no bounds as she actively participates in the group meetings, manages the store, and even ventures out independently. One fateful meeting revealed a distressing situation: a fellow member was troubled by the prospect of her daughter's early marriage.

Upon inquiry, it was revealed that the daughter was only 16 years old, and the family intended to marry her off without any expenses, expecting the groom's family to bear the burden. Afsana intervened, enlightening them about the ramifications of child marriage on both the physical and mental well-being of the girl. She emphasized that the legal age for marriage is 18, and flouting this law could lead to imprisonment and hefty fines.

Through relentless persuasion and the collective support of the group members, Afsana successfully prevented the girl's marriage. She takes pride in her association with Jeevika, acknowledging the countless women like her who have stepped out of their homes, shoulder to shoulder with their husbands, transforming their families' financial status and realizing their dreams.

Afsana Khatoon's journey epitomizes the spirit of empowerment and resilience, showcasing how collective action can break the shackles of tradition and pave the way for a brighter future. Her tale serves as an inspiration for women everywhere, demonstrating that with determination and support, they can overcome any obstacle and rewrite their destinies.

Venturing beyond horticulture, Shanti Sharan diversified her portfolio by venturing into dairy farming, utilizing cow dung to produce organic fertilizers and even creating herbal remedies for commercial sale. Additionally, she ventured into mushroom cultivation and beekeeping, significantly enhancing her economic prospects.

Today, Shanti Sharan's monthly income ranges between \$\pi\$18,000 to \$\pi\$20,000, a testament to her unwavering determination and entrepreneurial spirit. She ensured her children received quality education, breaking the cycle of financial dependency. During a pivotal meeting of the group, she solemnly pledged alongside her fellow members that neither she nor her children would engage in or accept dowry.
