Subject: - Financial Inclusion programme on 09.03.2013.

Dear DPMs,

It has been communicated vide CEO's Office Order ref. no. BRLPS/Project/405/13/4137 dated 27.02.2013 that a programme on Financial Inclusion of Self Help Groups has been scheduled at S.K. Memorial Hall, Patna on 09.03.2013 during which more than 10 thousand SHGs would be credit linked and the programme would be graced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Bihar.

It has been directed that from each of 9 districts, nearly 200 female community members would participate in the meeting. Arrangements for safe and comfortable stay with food and lodging of these members at Patna is being made by the SPMU logistic team from the evening of 08.03.2013 till morning of 10.03.2013.

District wise selection of participating community members as well as their safe and comfortable journey from concerned district to Patna and back has to be arranged by the concerned district teams.

It is desirable that all community members are taken to respective places of stay at Patna by the evening of 08.03.2013.

Each district needs to constitute a team for selection of participating community members as well as for ensuring their safe journey. For this purpose, the DPCU team may hire vehicles (Bus, Mini bus, etc.) following procurement norms. *Over loading in any of the vehicles carrying community members/ participants is strictly prohibited.* For this programme, concerned districts should send budget detailing out budget heads and budget-line for approval. This should reach SPMU by 04.03.2013.

At least 5 (including 2 female staff) responsible officials of each district should accompany participating women during this journey. They have to ensure proper medical care in case of need. With regard to places of stay and logistic arrangements, members of SPMU logistic team may also be contacted.
