Office Order

SPMU level Enquiry Committee found nine Young Professionals found guilty of submitting manipulated claims for reimbursement of hotel bills to DPCU, Gaya. Show cause notices were issued to them by DPM, DPCU, Gaya, in reply to which they accepted their mistakes and apologised for that. It was also found that manipulated bills were not paid to them.

The Enquiry Committee Report along with its recommendations was considered by the Management and it was decided to allow them to continue in their services with strong warning not to repeat the same in future and if in future they commit any financial irregularity, their services would be terminated.

Besides they were ordered to be given the following punishments:

- 1. Stoppage of one annual increment without cumulative effect.
- Stoppage of payment of performance incentive for 2012-13.

In respect of due amount which was spent by YPs and was not reimbursed to them, the Management took the decision that DPM, Gaya should reimburse actual amount lawfully payable to them.
