For quick and exact transmission of monthly progress reports relating to various themes, use of "NRLM web portal" and "Google Doc" is available and the link for the same has been provided to all DPCUs and BPIUs.

Decision has been taken that from now onwards all reports have to be through uploading on NRLM web Portal and Google Doc.

Accordingly DPMs should ensure updating of data relating to progress during preceding month on all themes by the 7th of every month.

Similarly, BPMs have to ensure submission of soft copy of report relating to NRLM MPR in the format attached herewith by 5th of every month to the nodal person at district level.

DPCUs are required to undertake the following activities –

1. Uploading the Block wise target on the basis of approved district AAP.
2. Uploading cumulative progress till March-14 of each block.
3. Uploading the monthly progress for the month of April, May and June -14.
4. From July 2014 onwards, progress for the concerned month only be uploaded.

DPM will ensure the above as per the deadlines.
