As per MoRD's guidelines, an Intensive Participatory Planning Exercise (IPPE) has to be conducted in all the wards of 293 blocks of the state. Government of Bihar has decided to take up this IPPE initiative in all the wards of 534 blocks and also done some key value addition to the IPPE project so as to include schemes not just pertaining to MGNREGA but also with a strong focus on convergence across various themes such as livelihoods, skills, sanitation, infrastructure, social forestry, fisheries, water resources & other entitlements.

As per Letter No. 203941, Dated 30-9-2014, Government of Bihar has given Jeevika implementation & monitoring responsibility of the IPPE initiative for all the 534 blocks of the state. To make this ambitious initiative successful an **IPPE State Monitoring Unit** is being constituted as follows:

1. Smt. Archana Tiwari, SPM SD (Team Leader)
2. Shri. Ajit Ranjan, SPM M&E
3. Shri. Niraj Kumar Singh, PM, Entitlement
4. Shri. Chintan Raj, PMRDF

To support the IPPE Monitoring Unit a dedicated working group of professionals is to be deputed at SPMU from the following themes with immediate effect:

1. Communication – 5 Communication Managers
2. Monitoring & Evaluation – 4 Monitoring & Evaluation Managers
3. Social Development – 2 Social Development Managers
4. Livelihood – 2 representative who have livelihood related subject matter expertise
5. PMRDFs – 3 on a rotating basis
6. Administration – 1 Accountant, 1 Hindi typist, 1 Computer operator

All other Project Co-ordinators and State Project Managers will extend their support as and when required by the **IPPE State Monitoring Unit**. Shri Rajesh Parimal, Administrative Officer will ensure that dedicated space for all deputed members of State Monitoring Unit is arranged at Jeevika Office at Biscomaun.
