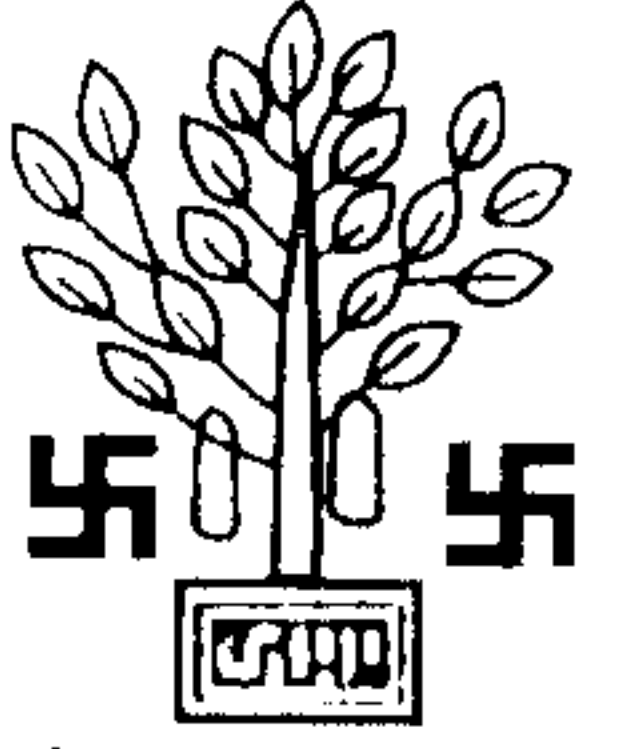

OFFICE ORDER

BRLPS is all set to scale up in two Forty (239) new Blocks in the thirty eight (38) Districts of Bihar. The project has already Started two ninety five (295) BPIUs in across all the Districts, where DPCUs are functional and they are coordinating, providing their support in the implementation and reviewing the progress of the activities performed. The 38 DPCUs & SPMU have to take up the challenge to operationalise the JEEViKA Model.

In order to achieve systematic and timely expansion, the BPIU, DPCUs & SPMU teams need to work together and follow the instructions given below diligently:

1. The DPCUs will ensure deployment of one AC and two CCs in the newer blocks.
2. The newly joined staffs in these expansion blocks will attend one day orientation workshop at District and will move to the new blocks to perform the tasks mentioned in the Indicative list.
3. The staff placed in the new expansion Blocks will claim lodging and TA/DA from the district for a maximum of 7 working days.
4. The DPCUs will provide an imprest amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) per block for day to day operations and miscellaneous expenditures.
5. The supporting district will continue to assist the newer districts in operationalization of JEEViKA intervention.
6. The new BPIUs are authorized to hire vehicle for a maximum of 15 days in a month at a maximum daily rate of Rs. 1250/- (Rupees one thousand two hundred and fifty) only per month (inclusive of expenditure on fuel and driver) with prior approval from district incharge/DPM.

7. The DPCU will form a Committee on expansion to ensure smooth functioning and deliverables as per the indicative list.

To work out scaling up strategies and providing handholding support for the establishment of operations in the Districts named below, a cell has already been created in SPMU consisting of the SPM Resource Cell, SPM IB & CB, SPM M& E, SPM HRD, PM MF, Procurement Specialist, Administrative officer and State Finance Manager (Mr Uday Kumar Verma).

Indicative list of the tasks for one month:

Sl.No	Parameters
1	Identify an office of 1500 to 2000 square feet with 3-4 rooms for a maximum hiring limit of Rs. 3000-5000/- per month, Generators (up to Rs 11000/-per month for 150 hrs) and Telephone with internet connectivity within the time frame and under procurement norms.
2	New BPIUs will open Block office before 28 th Feb 2014 and will start project deliverables from 1 st March 2014
3	Ensure that the new account- CID is opened before 7 th Mar, 2014
4	The cashbook of each new DPCU to be maintained separately as per the norms of the Society
5	Follow up of SHG mapping & Field Validation for at least 5-10 SHGs of the Project Blocks.
6	2 Village Selection in the 1 st month and CM identification
8	CRP round for field validation
