OFFICE ORDER

BRLPS (Jeevika) has made significant strides to form quality community institutions and its nurturing. All efforts are being made to make these community institutions dynamics, decision oriented and sustainable over a period of time. One of the ways to do had been providing community institutions with the Establishment Fund in order to give the community institutions an identity and way ahead for common discussion and decision.

During the visit of Internal Support Team (IST) to different districts, it was evident and explicit that timely availability of establishment fund will aid the process of strengthening and sustainability of the community institutions. Based on the above facts, following has been approved by the competent authority:

- a) Direction has been given for ensuring transfer of "Establishment Fund" to different levels of Community Institutions as per the stipulated laid down norms.
- b) The budgetary approval for FY 2018-19 circulated to districts may be enhanced to the limit of requirement of providing "Establishment Fund" to different levels of Community Institutions.
- c) All districts have been directed to provide "Establishment Fund" to different levels of community institutions. The unit cost remains as per the laid down limitations. At present the "Establishment Fund" for SHG and VO stands at Rs.1000/ (Rs. One Thousand Only) and Rs.4200/ (Rs. Four Thousand and Two Hundred Only) respectively. The same has been communicated through office order BRLPS/Pro/39/09/1498 dated 30th September 2011.
- d) It will be fair to mention that "Establishment Fund" and "Fund for Community Institution Material" is same.

Considering the importance of release of Establishment Fund or Fund for Community Institution Material, all DPMs are directed to ensure transfer into the accounts of related community institutions.
