Addendum of the Office Order No. BRLPS/Proj-LH/1172/17/3136 dated 04.11.2017

In order to meet the current requirement of the project under the convergence programme of the Dept. of Agriculture, GoB, the following points have been approved in addendum of the office order.

1. In line with point no. 5 of the aforementioned Office Order, the unit cost of CHCs is being changed. The current cost per unit for the establishment of CHC is as follows:

a. Aspirational District: The Department of Agriculture has selected 13 districts (refer Annexure I) as the aspirational districts for establishment of CHCs. Thus, target of CHCs is being revised and every district must ensure the submission of online application till 30.11.2021. After receiving sanction order from the Department of Agriculture, CLFs/VOs may proceed with further processes of procurement as per the CHC guidelines of BRLPS. The CLF/VO will receive Rs. 10,00,000 only as the project cost for establishment. The subsidy received from the Dept. of Agriculture may be used in CLF to cover CHC start-up and other operational costs such as shed construction, driver expenses, diesel expenses, leasing of space, extra equipment purchase, repair of equipment's, insurance of machinery etc. The expenditure may be done with proposal in agreement with SPMU. Detail is mentioned on annexure. IV.

b. Non-Aspirational Districts (Full Cost Model): Under this model, BRLPS will provide the entire establishment cost subject to the fulfilment of the following criteria.

i. The district must get a declaration from the Department of Agriculture stating that the CHC Subsidy Fund is not available in FY 2021-22. Following receipt of the declaration, the district would communicate with designated CLFs to begin the establishment process in accordance with the guidelines. The concerned CLF would receive fund up to Rs. 13,50,000 per CHC through the project.

- c. **Flexi Fund of DoA for Special CHC:** The Districts in this category may be allowed to develop CHCs costing up to Rs. 20,00,000. The concerned CLF will have to apply in the Department of Agriculture for the Special CHC, and once approved, CLF would be able to proceed for establishment procedure. According to the Department of Agriculture guidance (As per Annexure-II & III), the CLF will purchase a 55 HP tractor and equipment relevant to crop residue management practises.
2. The serial No. 1 (a), (b), and (c) unit costs are to be considered as a grant for the CLF and are not to be repaid to the project. The subsidy fund will only be used to buy extra or other machinery for rental that is extremely relevant and needed in the region, as well as approved at the CLF meeting.
 3. CLF may utilise its corpus for the expenditure (other than machinery) till the subsidy is received from the Department of Agriculture. Required Bookkeeping in CLF should be done properly.
 4. The foregoing provisions in points 1, 2 and 3 will be considered as a revised update to the CHC guideline (BRLPS/Proj-LH/1172/17/3136 dated 04.11.2017), and districts may operate in accordance with them until a new guideline is issued.
 5. Every expenditure in CHC establishment and related business activity / transaction should be entered in CHC App. App link is given below:

 6. Books of record for CHC establishment and related business activity / transaction to be completed by 30th Dec-2021. Further it would be updated regularly.
 7. For the FY-2021-22 the revised target and Budget is given in the Annexure I.

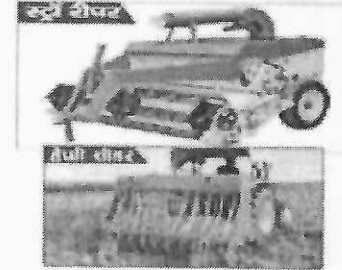

जीविका के समूह / ग्राम संगठन / क्लस्टर फेडरेशन, आत्मा से संबद्ध फार्मर इन्ट्रेस्ट ग्रुप (FIG), नाबार्ड / राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंक से संबद्ध किसान क्लब, Farmer Producer Organization (FPO), स्वयं सहायता समूह, निर्माता / उद्यमी (Entrepreneur) एवं प्रगतिशील कृषकों को कृषि यंत्र बैंक स्थापित करने का सुनहरा अवसर

कृषि विभाग, बिहार सरकार द्वारा वित्तीय वर्ष 2021-22 में सब मिशन ऑन एग्रीकल्चरल मेकेनाइजेशन योजनान्तर्गत फलेक्सी फण्ड के तहत 300.00 लाख (तीन करोड़) रुपये की लागत से कृषि यंत्र बैंक स्थापित किया जाना है।

- ❖ बिहार राज्य के कैमूर, रोहतास, भोजपुर, नालन्दा, बक्सर, पटना, नवादा, गया, औरंगाबाद जिलों में 20 लाख रुपये तक की लागत वाले कुल 25 स्पेशल कस्टम हायरिंग सेन्टर (कृषि यंत्र बैंक) की स्थापना किया जाना है, जिस पर 80 प्रतिशत अधिकतम 12.00 लाख रुपये प्रति कृषि यंत्र बैंक अनुदान दिया जायेगा।
- ❖ प्रत्येक कृषि यंत्र बैंक के लिए कम-से-कम तीन फसल अवशेष प्रबंधन के यंत्रों का क्रय करना अनिवार्य है।
- ❖ इसके लिए 55 PTO HP तक के ट्रैक्टर पर 40 प्रतिशत अधिकतम 3.40 लाख (तीन लाख चालीस हजार) रुपये अनुदान देय है, जबकि अन्य यंत्रों पर 80 प्रतिशत अनुदान देय है।
- ❖ राज्य के इच्छुक जीविका के समूह / ग्राम संगठन / क्लस्टर फेडरेशन, आत्मा से संबद्ध फार्मर इन्ट्रेस्ट ग्रुप (FIG), नाबार्ड / राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंक से संबद्ध किसान क्लब, Farmer Producer Organization (FPO) / स्वयं सहायता समूह, निर्माता / उद्यमी (Entrepreneur) एवं प्रगतिशील कृषक अपनी सुविधानुसार, कहीं से भी ऑनलाईन आवेदन कर सकते हैं। कृषि यंत्र बैंक स्थापित करने हेतु कृषि विभाग के Website : www.farmech.bih.nic.in पर दिनांक 27.10.2021 से 30.11.2021 तक ऑनलाईन आवेदन किया जा सकता है।
