

## Training cum Production Centre for Stitching - 1st Phase

The textile industry in India is traditionally second largest employment generation industry after agriculture, it is the only industry that has generated huge employment for both skilled and unskilled labour in textiles industry. Analysing the success in mask production and visualising the large number of women involved in stitching, JEEViKA decided to establish "Nodal Training cum Production Centers for Stitching" for controlled and quality product stitching and supply.

To be sustainable, units have to sell their products through tieup with different Govt. Deptts. Like-Education, Health, etc as well as in the open market.

Approval has been given on Pilot basis for setting up of:

1. Nodal Training cum Production Centres in second phase at Goraul –Vaishali in collaboration with the Industry Department, which encompass machinery of total 8 Nodal Training cum Production Centres.

- 3. Concerned NF-Manager will be responsible for the unit establishment in coordination with concerned BPM/BPMs and SPMU team with support of Concerned Production Manager.
- 4. Concerned Procurement Manager will ensure procurement of all required materials (Specification and quantity as mentioned in Annexure) for the unit establishment in coordination with concerned Manager NF and BPM.
- 5. All the compliance and statuary requirement like –ESI, Insurance (of Unit as well as members), Safety norms, Inventry management etc should be ensured by DPCU Team.
- 6. Separate Manpower will be placed At Production centres.
