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Office order regarding the ET/TT Vaccination drive

To enhance the income of SHG members, JEEViKA is implementing the Goat Intervention with the objective of reducing mortality and morbidity and enhancing the productivity of goats through preventive services rendered by Pashu Sakhis. As part of the regular preventive health calendar, the ET/TT (Enterotoxaemia/Tetanus Toxoid) Vaccination Drive is undertaken during this period following completion of the Deworming Drive, so as to further strengthen the disease-preventive health cover of goats reared by SHG members.

In this regard, the ET/TT Vaccination Drive shall be initiated with effect from **15th September, 2026** and should be completed by **30th September, 2026** positively, through all active Pashu Sakhis.

The following instructions shall be ensured by all concerned:

1. Adequate care shall be taken that goats which have completed deworming at least 14 days prior are administered the vaccine, so as to achieve optimal vaccine effectiveness.
2. The vaccination activity shall be undertaken in drive mode by all active Phase 2 trained Pashu Sakhis, ensuring maximum coverage of eligible goat-rearing households.
3. All concerned **Block Livestock Nodal/Livelihood Specialist** shall ensure timely mobilisation and placement of the demand for ET/TT vaccine with Seemanchal Jeevika Goat Producer Company Limited well in advance, so as to ensure uninterrupted availability of the vaccine throughout the drive period.
4. Cold chain maintenance, including adequate provisioning of requirements such as ice packs and vaccine carriers, shall be strictly ensured at all levels — from storage to point of administration — to preserve vaccine potency.
5. Pashu Sakhis shall ensure daily entry of the vaccination activity, along with the corresponding vaccination date of each goat, in the designated application/reporting mechanism.
6. The concerned Block Livestock Nodal shall regularly monitor the progress and ensure daily reporting of the ET/TT Vaccination Drive to the DPCU team, and the District Livestock Nodal shall accordingly report to the SPMU team in the prescribed format.
7. The concerned BPMs shall ensure effective implementation of the vaccination activity through Pashu Sakhis.

All concerned are directed to ensure strict compliance with the above instructions and timely completion of the ET/TT Vaccination Drive.
