Office Order

(Organizing camps on Credit link Subsidy Scheme/Seed Capital under PMFME Schemes)

BRLPS (JEEViKA) has been making incessant effort to facilitate Income Generation Activities by ensuring Credit linkage Schemes. This has stood in good stead for the community members. There is lot of Struggle during credit linkage schemes. Many Departments and Banks insist for filling on line application and credit information to SHGs Members. This is appearing as one of the limitations. Similarly, there is little awareness about PMFME (Seed Capital and Credit Link subsidy Scheme) and District Resource Person (DRP) under PMFME and their working. It is possible to have a confluence of Credit literacy where the amalgamation of work of Form generation can be done with lot of input from District Resource Person (DRP) and other Resource Person to spread awareness about the work they are doing.

- Organizing Camp for Credit link subsidy scheme under PMFME-under up gradation of Processing Units Individual Category, Individual micro food processing units would be extended credit-linked capital subsidy @35% of the eligible project cost for expansion/ technology up gradation with a maximum ceiling of Rs.10 lakh per unit. The beneficiary contribution should be minimum 10% and the balance should be loan from a Bank.
- Training and Capacity Building of Beneficiaries- Training to individual and group beneficiaries will focus on entrepreneurship development, essential functions of enterprise operations, book keeping, registration, FSSAI standards, Udyog Aadhar, GST Registration, general hygiene, packaging, marketing etc. Specific training designed on the model of ODOP and the vertical focus products will be undertaken nearer to the work place of the entrepreneurs. Existing infrastructure of Rural Self Employment. Most Important regarding repayment and utilization of seed capital amount.

Based on above facts, approval is being for following:-

a) Approval has been accorded for an expenditure of an amount up to Rs.10000/-(Rs. Ten Thousand only) to each of the BPIU for Organizing camps on Credit link Subsidy Scheme/Seed Capital under PMFME Schemes with entrepreneur/leaders/SHG members/others.

- b) The Scheduled approval is period for period from January to February2023. This translates in to the fact that maximum of Rs.10000/-(Rs. Ten Thousand only) can be spent over a period of two months by related BPIUs.
- c) Entrepreneur of SHGs/leaders/SHG members/DRP may be called to common agreed centre and briefing needs to be done about the way. Functions and Services they can take from related centers.DRP/Resource Person can be paid a fee of maximum of Rs.500/-(Rs. Five Hundred Only) for facilitating discussion and lending a helping hand in generation of minimum Ten loan application. This is for one day as fee.
- d) BPMs are directed to utilize the resource in the most prudent way and ensure that all interested members got on line application numbers and resolve without any further delay.
- e) BPMs will also appoint a Nodal Person to coordinated the activities said Camp.
- f) The Scheduled Nodal Person will ensure that minutes of the campus are prepared along with the names of Entrepreneur of SHGs/leaders/SHG members/others who will interested in Credit link Subsidy Scheme/Seed Capital under PMFME. Needs to be put as documentation.
- g) DPMs/BPMs are required to be report the same to SPMU/DPCU respectively.
- h) DPMs/BPMs needs to ensure that the scheduled Credit link Subsidy Scheme/Seed Capital under PMFME campus yields dividends in terms of more application generation in terms of PMFME seed capital as well as Credit link subsidy scheme.
