

**Office Order****Target under PMFME, Seed Capital for FY 2023-24**

Self-Help Groups (SHGs)/ SHG members presently engaged in Micro Food Processing (MFP) activities with an experience of at least one year are eligible to apply for seed capital under the PMFME Scheme. Food processing refers to transforming raw materials or agricultural produce into any other consumable form with a shelf life and packaging done for the market. The SHG members have to commit to utilizing this amount for working capital as well as for the purchase of small tools and give a commitment in this regard to the SHG, Village Organization and Cluster-level federation.

The target for the Financial Year 2023-24 with the timeline in light of “**Mass Disbursement of seed Capital in World Food India 2023**” and Consultation with Department of Industries, Government of Bihar (SNA), which needs to be completed by the end of June 2023. MIS team at SPMU shall support the district team in technical issues throughout the program so that all technical issues can be resolved

The scheme envisages the provision of Seed Capital @ Rs. 40,000/- per member of SHG engaged in food processing for working capital and the purchase of small tools. Seed capital as a grant would be provided at the federation level of SHGs, which, in turn, will be extended to members as a loan through Community Based Organizations

Therefore, you all are instructed to start the entry process on the NRLM MIS portal. The data has to be submitted to SNA without failure. The district-wise target for FY 2023-24 is given below-
